

Guidelines for Six Fresh Eggs - Class 104

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Guidelines for Egg Exhibitors

All the eggs should be as fresh as possible, and not refrigerated.

They should be uniform in size, colour and shape, with shells of a good texture and free from dirt, stains and impurities.

When presenting the eggs try to avoid using hay as this can taint them - straw, sawdust or shredded paper are preferable. If you decide to present on a plate do bear in mind this can run the risk of cracking the shells.

When the judge breaks the egg he will be looking for a good coloured yolk, standing proud, and a white which is firm and translucent.
